### **Integrates with Progressbook**

- Grades are automatically posted to the grade book in Progressbook as assignments are completed.

### **Fully Online Remote Learning**

- Provides an alternative to students while maintaining full enrollment and extracurricular activities.

### **Follows the Hillsdale Local Schools Calendar**

- Courses and assignments will be scheduled around the breaks built into the HLS calendar.

### **The curriculum can be customized**

- Teachers can customize the curriculum based on specific student needs (i.e. IEP or 504 Plans).
- Student schedules can be customized for any classes offered at the high school or online, including any combination.

### **Accessible online 24 hours a day using ProgressBook**

- Students can log in and complete assignments anytime or place where they have internet access.

### **Over 200 courses (K-12)**

- Students have access to the required Core Classes as well as a variety of electives (i.e. Elementary Spanish, Latin, 8th-grade Algebra, etc).

### **Contact with HLS Teachers**

- Students have contact with HLS teachers to ask questions and get clarification when needed.

### **Participate in School Activities**

- Students are still HLS students and can join all HLS extra-curricular activities throughout the year.
- Students are required to follow all rules and guidelines outlined in the student handbook. This includes sports eligibility, cheating consequences, graduation requirements, etc.

\* This curriculum is designed to be fully remote and some students will be able to complete courses with minimal assistance. It is highly recommended that all K-4 students have a learning support person who can assist in reading and understanding expectations.

\*Weekly check-ins with an assigned HLS teacher will be required along with the completion of all assignments.

## What to Expect:

- Once registration is complete you will be contacted by a school guidance counselor to set up your child's virtual coursework.
- Your child will be placed in HLS virtual classrooms with a certified teacher of record who will set the assignment schedule. This will be your contact person throughout the virtual assignments.
- If your child is in need of a learning device, one will be issued to them.
- Once the school year starts, you will need to check in weekly with your child's teacher via email or phone, to discuss progress and any potential concerns.

## What you need:

- Your child will need a computer that they can use on a regular basis. (if you do not have one, HLS can provide one)
- Reliable daily internet access is needed.

## Commitment:

- Students are highly encouraged to commit to a semester of virtual learning. Cases will be reviewed on an individual basis if needed.
