# AUTHORIZING CONTRACT WITH SIMONSON-REGENCY CONSTRUCTION SERVICES, LLC FOR THE MAINTENANCE BUILDING PROJECT.

The Superintendent recommends authorizing a contract with Simonson-Regency Construction Services, LLC ("Simonson-Regency"), for the Maintenance Building Project (the "Project").

## Background:

- 1. The Board previously identified a need to construct a new maintenance building for the Project.
- 2. The Project is outside the scope of the competitive bidding requirements defined in ORC 3313.46 only requires competitive bidding for work related to "school buildings," and the relevant work set forth in agreement is not to build, repair, enlarge, improve, or demolish a school building.
- 3. Accordingly, the District issued a request for proposals to qualified firms and two firms provided responses; of the two, Simonson-Regency was identified as the firm in the Board's best interest.
- 4. Simonson-Regency has provided a proposal to perform the design of the project in the amount of \$59,807.00; upon completion of the design, Simonson-Regency will provide a guaranteed maximum price for the construction of the Project.

The Hillsdale Local School District Board of Education resolves as follows:

- 1. The Board selects Simonson-Regency as the firm in the best interest of the District to perform the Project.
- 2. The Board authorizes the Superintendent and Treasurer to work with legal counsel to negotiate and execute a contract with Simonson-Regency in the initial amount of \$59,807.00 for the design of the project, and to execute any other documents necessary to effectuate the terms of the contract including any purchase orders.

### APPROVING CHANGE ORDER FOR THE NEW PREK-12 BUILDING PROJECT

The Superintendent recommends that the Board approve the Change Order revising the Guaranteed Maximum Price ("GMP") of the Construction Manager at Risk ("CMR") Agreement with Simonson-Regency Construction Services, LLC ("Simonson-Regency") for New PreK-12 Building Project (the "Project") in the total amount of \$296,656.00 and to add an additional scope of work to the Project.

#### Rationale:

- **1.** The Board previously approved a series of GMP Amendments with Simonson-Regency Construction Services (the "CMR") for the Project.
- 2. Following the CMR's bidding of the Work to potential subcontractors, the actual cost of the work was under budget; under the terms of the Agreement between the Board and CMR, such savings were retained by the Board to use in its discretion.
- **3.** During the course of the project, the District identified need to add security cameras, electronic security access controls, and security compartment doors throughout the new PK-12 facility to protect occupants within the building to the scope of the Project (the "Change Order Work").
- **4.** The cost of the Change Order Work will increase the GMP by \$296,656.00, which will be funded by the savings on the Project.

The Hillsdale Local School District Board of Education resolves as follows:

- 1. The Board approves the addition of the Change Order Work to the Project via a Change Order in an amount not to exceed \$296,656.00.
- **2.** The Board authorizes the Superintendent, Treasurer, and other officials and administrators to execute such Change Order and any other related documentation on behalf of the Board, consistent with this approval.

The Superintendent recommends that the Board approve the Change Order revising the Guaranteed Maximum Price ("GMP") of the Construction Manager at Risk ("CMR") Agreement with Simonson-Regency Construction Services, LLC ("Simonson-Regency") for New PreK-12 Building Project (the "Project").

#### Rationale:

- **5.** The Board previously approved a series of GMP Amendments with Simonson-Regency Construction Services (the "CMR") for the Project.
- **6.** Following the CMR's bidding of the Work to potential subcontractors, the actual cost of the work was under budget; under the terms of the Agreement between the Board and CMR, such savings were retained by the Board to use in its discretion.
- 7. During the course of the project, the District identified need to construct a concession stand and restrooms, located between the baseball and softball fields (the "Change Order Work").
- **8.** The cost of the Change Order Work will increase the GMP by \$352,545.60, which will be funded by the savings on the Project.
