### 2015-2016

- Full time technology coordinator
- Additional Agricultural/STEM (**Science, Technology, Engineering, Math**) instructor
- Upgrade of PreK-12<sup>th</sup> grade technology to be Wi-Fi compatible

### 2016-2017

- Curriculum updates for social studies and science
- Family Consumer Science classes
- Expanded College Credit Plus classes
- Expanded STEM classes
- Additional Foreign Language, Art and Music classes
- Replacement of aging transportation fleet with purchase of a new bus per year

### 2016-2017
