
Overall 85.8% of 246 survey respondents indicated that they were "very satisfied" to "expectations met" with the way the district managed the emergency remote learning at home this spring .






How did your child participate in remote learning? 245 responses

Which of the following best describes the computer/device your child used for distance learning? 222 responses




They used a computer/device owned by our family.


They used a laptop provided by the district.

How often did your child experience problems with the device they were using that interrupted their learning?




How often did your child experience WiFi issues that interrupted their learning? 222 responses




Does your home have an adequate number of devices AND internet service to meet the needs of all members of the family working from home? 222 responses




On average how many hours a week did your child spend on schoolwork? 246 responses




How satisfied are you with the school's remote learning arrangements? 246 responses




What have been the biggest challenges in transitioning to education at home?



What has worked well with the school's management of remote learning?




What additional supports would benefit your family?




How easy was it to contact your child's teacher?




How often did you receive communication from the teacher?


